

7 STEPS TO INCREMENT / DECREMENT BUTTONS

using Spreadsheet Converter

Cell Name="gw_1"

1. In Excel, create 4 columns for each item and populate as shown.
2. Convert the sheet, then open the .htm file in Dreamweaver.
3. Global replace* 'minus' with `<input type="button" id="minus" value="-" onClick="incr_val.value = (incr_val.value-1)">`
4. Global replace* 'plus' with `<input type="button" value="+" onClick="incr_val.value = (+incr_val.value+1)">`
5. Locate item (eg. Glassware) & replace 'incr_val' with respective name (eg 'gw_1').
6. Repeat for all other items.

* with care, after checking with Find Next ...

7. Once you've made all the changes, save the file and then switch back to Excel and share via DropBox, or simply copy the file and support folders, etc. to your website.
